

VOLUNTEER TASK: Ambassador

AMBASSADOR'S ROLE:

Ambassadors are as passionate as us, about getting local people's voices heard. They visit community group meetings to explain what Healthwatch does and to listen to local people's comments about health and social care services. They also represent Healthwatch at some Newham Council and health and social care service meetings and provide us with feedback. Sometimes Ambassadors help people complete questionnaires or hold small group conversations and workshops. The role involves talking to many communities and individuals in Newham, which provides an opportunity to learn more about community research, engagement and development.

REQUIREMENTS:

Friendly and polite manner to members of the public

Good verbal communication skills

Excellent listening skills

Knowledge or willingness to learn about the work of Healthwatch Willingness to represent Healthwatch & the views of Newham residents even if these differ from your own

Note taking at meetings

Good timekeeping & reliability

Able to travel around the Borough of Newham to attend events & meetings Attendance required will vary, therefore a flexible role

ADDITIONAL USEFUL SKILLS:

Knowledge of health and/or social care policy

Information management skills e.g. data inputting

Able to create or publish content for Healthwatch Newham's website and social media

Design/production skills re: communication and publicity materials

Induction to the organisation.

Instruction to prepare you for the role.

On-going guidance related to designated tasks

Regular volunteer support meetings.
